**Non-Deductible Tax Information:** Compliance with the Tax Reform Act of 1993, as amended by the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act of 2017, requires that the portion of dues attributable to lobbying and political activities at the Local, State and Federal levels of government be considered Non-deductible for income tax purposes.

\$118.00 of your Washington Realtors dues and \$57.00 of your National Association of Realtors dues are not deductible for federal income tax purposes. \$35.00 of your Washington State dues will be deposited into the Washington REALTOR Political Action Committee (Washington State RPAC) as a contribution on your behalf, if you would prefer that the \$35 go to issue advocacy purposes instead you may send us an email at [issuesfund@warealtor.org](mailto:issuesfund@warealtor.org) and the required \$35.00 will be directed to our non-PAC state issues fund.

**\*\* New Member, Transfer or Reinstatement Fee:**

1. New members paying \$150.00 new member fee will receive a \$40 refund after attending Orientation and completing Code of Ethics Training.
2. A REALTOR® applicant, who left NPSAR membership in good standing within the past three (3) years will be required to attend Orientation and will be charged a \$50.00 reactivation fee and will pay dues prorated as per Article X of the Bylaws.
3. REALTORS® transferring from another REALTOR® Association, where he/she was a member in good standing, where his/her local, state and national dues are current, will be charged the prorated amount of the Association board dues as per Article X Section 2 of the Bylaws. They will pay a \$50.00 transfer fee and will be expected to attend Association Orientation.
